From the Pastor's Pen

From their earliest years, parents begin to teach their children to achieve goals. Tying the laces of their shoes. Combing their hair. Doing their homework. As children grow into their teenage years, they begin to set goals for themselves. Good grooming. Being polite. Developing skills.

Once into adulthood, different goals are set. Advanced education. Friendships. A vocation in life. Religious practices. For those who are disciples of Jesus, goals come from reading the Scripture, going to church, living the great law of love. But the ultimate goal is a favorable judgment at the time of death and a place in the Kingdom of God.

Did Jesus have goals? In the fullness of his human nature, we would conclude that he did. As recorded in the gospels, He spoke of them. Doing the will of the Heavenly Father. Proclaiming the good news. Calling disciples. Sharing the ways of mercy.

There was an ultimate goal at the end of his mission: to be with the Heavenly Father. On this feast of the Ascension, we celebrate his homecoming. We don't understand fully the meaning of "ascending." Hearing that word we think of "going up." And yet the Kingdom of God is not "up," not out there in the far universe somewhere. As Jesus taught: "The Kingdom of God is among you." (Lk 17,20). So the goal of Jesus is not to be away from us, but to be with us always.

The accounts about the ascension of Jesus in the Acts of the Apostles ("a cloud took him from their sight") and from the gospel of Luke ("He was taken up to heaven") are not about absence but about a different kind of presence among us.

The Jesus we adore and follow is the presence of the Risen Lord in our midst.

My prayers are with you each day.

Meditating Moments



Over the past few weeks there have been many photographs of Pope Leo XIV appearing in the news and on social media. The one above

is my favorite because he is surrounded by God's natural beauty of spring blooms. The Pope seems relaxed and filled with the hope, peace, and the true joy of Christ, even as the weight of the papacy has become a reality for him. His smile and raised hand also seem to **welcome all people of the world.**

The one to the right, however, even though I don't know the context, seems to be directed at me and to all who proclaim to be followers of Christ Jesus. The Pope's expression and finger remind me of the Carravaggio painting "The Calling of Matthew."



In that painting, Jesus is pointing directly at Matthew the tax collector, calling him to follow, leave his life behind, and become a disciple. The Pope seems to be asking me, "Have you left your old self-centered life behind? Are you (Sandy G.) a true follower and disciple of Jesus? How do you live the Gospel message, especially in your day to day encounters with others, your culture and society, your comfortable life style?" He seems to be saying, "Are you willing to make sacrifices, to embrace change for the benefit of your fellow human beings? Will you protect God's creation for future generations? Come, journey with me as we try to live our lives, guided by the Holy Spirit, as true believers in Christ Jesus. Together, let us build His kingdom. Let us be loving and forgiving. Let us build bridges not walls."

In these images of our new Pope I do not see a man grasping for power or privilege. I do not see a man full of pride and self centeredness. I see a man, a leader who seeks synodality working with both clergy and laity within the Church but also a man who brings the voice of Christ to all people throughout the world. I see a man welcoming and speaking for the voiceless, but I also see a man who is saying "I cannot do God's work alone. I need you!" Looking at these two photographs I ask myself if I am filled with the joy of Jesus and am I willing to take the journey to follow Him, which may lead to unknown and mysterious places and encounters. I feel called, filled with uncertainty and love.

Meet Sam Fleming Our New Director of Liturgy and Music



Sam Fleming is known throughout the United States and parts of South America as a conductor, composer, organist, and music educator. He has held various conducting positions with community, church, and school ensembles. He is experienced as a conductor equally on the concert stage, in worship, and in musical theatre. As an organist, Fleming has performed throughout the United States as a soloist and with several choral ensembles and chamber groups. Fleming's compositions have been commissioned and premiered by various solo artists, community, church, schools, and university ensembles. His works are published through his own publishing company, SFM Publishing.

Fleming was appointed Director of Music and Liturgy at St. James in May 2025. He also serves on the faculty at Ottawa University in Ottawa, Kansas. Prior to his appointment at St. James, he held positions as Director of Music and Organist at the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd in Kansas City, Missouri, Director of Worship and Arts/Organist at First United Methodist Church in Florence, Alabama, and as an adjunct professor the keyboard and choral areas at the University of North Alabama. In addition, Fleming maintains a private studio where he teaches organ, piano, conducting, composition, and voice.

He recently completed the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Church Music with dual emphasis in Choral Conducting and Organ at the University of Kansas. He also holds a Master of Music degree in Choral Conducting from Illinois State University and a Bachelor of Musical Arts degree in Organ Performance and Music Composition from Brigham Young University - Idaho. Fleming is a member of the American Guild of Organists (AGO), the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP), and Pi Kappa Lambda Music Honor Society. He currently resides in Kansas City, Missouri, with his family.

**Members of the World Apostolate of Fatima (Kansas City/St. Joseph Chapter)
Will Join Us at the June 7 Devotion**

The World Apostolate of Fatima – Our Lady's Blue Army – is made up of individual members around the world who strive to practice the spiritual requests of Our Lady of Fatima in reparation for sins, for the conversion of sinners, for the salvation of souls, and to obtain the triumph of her Immaculate Heart and peace in the world.

In the early years of the Cold War, having discovered Our Lady of Fatima's message, Msgr. Harold V. Colgan partnered with John M. Haffert to create the "Blue Army of Our Lady of Fatima".

Members of this "Blue Army" were the spiritual force standing against the atheistic policies of the Soviet Union and their Red Army. They pledged to offer their daily sufferings and difficulties for the conversion of sinners, to pray the Rosary daily, to wear the Brown Scapular as a sign of consecration to Mary's Immaculate Heart, and to practice the Five First Saturdays devotion.

The pledge, which Sister Lucia herself helped formulate, quickly gained popularity throughout the United States and soon became a worldwide movement, with between thirty and forty million people having signed the Blue Army Pledge. Sister Lucia was one of the three shepherd children to whom Mary appeared in 1917.

The Blue Army of Our Lady of Fatima officially became the World Apostolate of Fatima and on October 7, 2010 was named a Public International Asso-

ciation of the Faithful. Today it serves as the Church's official voice on the authentic message of Fatima.

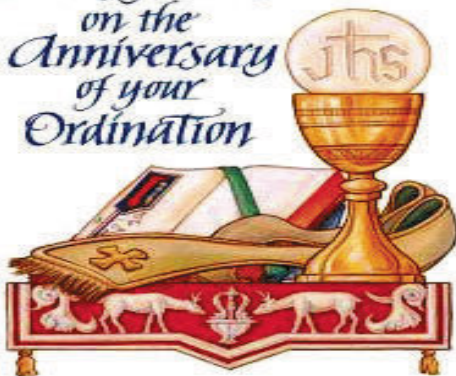
