The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Friday, June 27



Although not a Holy Day of Obligation, the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is an important liturgical day in the Catholic Church.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back at least to the 11th century, but through

the 16th century, it remained a private devotion, often tied to devotion to the Five Wounds of Christ.

The first feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated on August 31, 1670, in Rennes, France, through the efforts of Fr. Jean Eudes (1602-1680). From Rennes, the devotion spread, but it took the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) for the devotion to become universal.

In all of these visions, in which Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary, the Sacred Heart of Jesus played a central role. The "great apparition," which took place on June 16, 1675, during the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, is the source of the modern Feast of the Sacred Heart. In that vision, Christ asked St. Margaret Mary to request that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the octave (or eighth day) of the Feast of Corpus Christi, in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice that Christ had made for them.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents not simply His physical heart but His love for all mankind.

The devotion became quite popular after St. Margaret Mary's death in 1690, but, because the Church initially had doubts about the validity of St. Margaret Mary's visions, it wasn't until 1765 that the feast was celebrated officially in France. Almost 100 years later, in 1856, Pope Pius IX, at the request of the French bishops, extended the feast to the universal Church. It is celebrated on the day requested by our Lord—the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ), or 19 days after Pentecost Sunday.

Meditating Moments



Martin Luther King Jr. has been quoted as saying: "Use me God. Show me how to take who I am, who I want to be, and what I can do, and use it for a purpose greater than myself." With the conclusion of Mystogogy, on June 8th, for those receiving the Sacraments

of Initiation at this year's Easter Vigil, I asked our youngest members: "How can or do you use the gifts you received from the Holy Spirit for a purpose greater than yourself." Without exception their replies focused on how they help others. Although each response had a unique focus the theme was clear: kindness, honesty, patience, encouragement, and trust. These young people also stated that what they liked most about their faith journey over the past year, was 1. getting to know Jesus, 2. learning about what Catholics believe, 3. receiving the sacraments, and 4. meeting new people. I will miss these young men and women and sincerely value the lessons they taught me.

While I reflect on our times together, I remember how many expressions of kindness, patience, and thankfulness we shared. I know they cannot quote the catechisms, however, they share the heart of Jesus, to love God, through loving service to one another. I wonder if I too share the heart of Jesus. I know I love Jesus and desire to be a faithful disciple, however, I also know my own temperament and realize there are too many times when I fail to put the needs of others before my own wants and desires. One might suggest that I have a control problem, that is I frequently desire to be in control of most situations. There are also times when I believe my thinking and ideals are absolutely correct, and other people should share these ideas and ideals. Fortunately, at times like this, I generally find myself alone and wondering why others step away. I know I have a strong personality and am passionate about my beliefs, however, I also know Jesus allowed people to draw their own conclusions and determine the way in which to follow Him. If there is one thing I am learning and trying to change in my life it is to **LET GO**. Only God knows absolute truth and my hope is that in listening to God's voice, I might learn to following Jesus' teachings of love and service. At this juncture in my life, without a plan, I pray for God's guidance. I believe, trusting in Jesus, I can let go and experience the hope, peace, and pure joy of following in His footsteps.

I pray; Lord, help me find purpose beyond my self-centered wants and desires. Guide me in your ways of reconciliation, love, and servant-hood.

Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist Tuesday, June 24



John the Baptist was a contemporary of Christ who was known for evangelization and his baptizing of Jesus Christ. When Jesus came to him to be baptized, John recognized him and said, "It is I who need baptism from you."

He was born through the intercession of God to Zechariah and Elizabeth, who was otherwise too old to bear children.

According to scriptures, the Angel Gabriel visited Elizabeth and Zechariah to tell them they would have a son and that they should name him John. Zechariah was skeptical and for this he was rendered mute until the time his son was born and named John, in fulfillment of God's will.

When Elizabeth was pregnant with John, she was visited by Mary, and John leapt in her womb. This revealed to Elizabeth that the child Mary carried was to be the Son of God.



Respect for Sacred Spaces

Pray that all people of faith would be free to gather in houses of worship without fear.

The very nature of a sacred space is that it is set apart from other spaces as a place to seek communion with the divine and thus should be treated with respect. In a pluralistic society such as ours, respect for sacred spaces is especially vital for the sake of civil peace, which is part of the common good.

In recent years, a wave of vandalism and arson has hit Catholic churches and statues. There have been over 320 attacks so far, and that number steadily continues to grow. Christians are not alone in defending their sacred spaces.

Terrorist attacks against Israel and ensuing outbreak of war caused antisemitic incidents in the U.S. to skyrocket, including shocking displays of open hatred, with acts of anti-Muslim hatred committed as well.


There is no greater threat to religious liberty than for one's house of worship to become a place of danger, and the country sadly finds itself in a place where that danger is real.
