



## From the Pastor's Pen

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked that February 8 be celebrated as World Marriage Day, and that February 7-14 be observed as National Marriage Week with the theme "Man and Woman He created them: together with purpose." Marriage, one of the seven sacraments of the Church, is a great sign which shows the presence of God in the life of the Church and world. The love and fidelity of married couples are signs of our heavenly Father's love and faithfulness for us. With so many challenges to a couple's love and fidelity, we use this opportunity to pray intensely for all couples as they live their vocation, overcoming all the obstacles and challenges that confront them. Let that be your special intention this week.

Also the Pontifical Council for Peace and Justice has designated this Sunday, February 8, to be observed as the annual Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking. It is very appropriate that we observe this day on the feast of Saint Josephine Bakhita, who herself was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy.



Human trafficking is a horrible violation of human dignity when people are used as a commodity for profit. It is estimated that about a million people are trafficked each year globally, and that between 20,000 and 50,000 are trafficked into the United States. The United Nations names three categories: sex trafficking, labor trafficking, and the removal of organs. Much more information can be found on the Internet. The task for all of us is awareness, reporting, and prayer.



At this first meeting, we can discuss best days and times that the group would like to schedule monthly get-togethers.



## Meditating Moments



Recently I read an article stating that Pope Leo XIV believes it necessary to revisit documents of the Second Vatican Council and proposed to begin catechesis to the faithful in this regard. Reading his words I thought it was time to revisit these important documents for myself; it has been many years since I studied these documents as a Master's student at

Loyola University-New Orleans. Since it is so important as part of my worship, I began with *Sacrosanctum Concilium—The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy*.

Driven by serious scholarly work and theology, the liturgical movement began in the first decade of the 20th century, first in European abbeys and universities, eventually spreading to North America. Not surprising, therefore, early work of the council focused on liturgy, with the preparatory commission including experts and pastoral leaders from 19 nations. The council overwhelmingly approved the final document (with a vote of 2,147 to 4) which was promulgated by Pope Paul VI on December 4, 1963. This was the first document approved and had far-reaching effects on the faithful; around the world Catholics were called to full-active participation in the rites of the Mass and other sacraments, focusing on our formation as the "Body of Christ."


*The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy* is a beautiful document to read and embrace. I think there are four significant points to consider. First, this document makes clear that the Church is the whole people of God, calling each of us to consciously and actively participate in the Mass and in the Sacraments. The Church is not simply the Pope, priests, or vowed religious, rather the Church is all the faithful, God's beloved children. Second, baptism linked to confirmation was restored as the essential sacrament of ministry. The ordained were no longer the sole ministers but each of the baptized was called to active ministry. Third, the recognition that local parishes and dioceses constitute full expression of the Church, rather than merely geographical divisions. Thus, the document encouraged and allowed for the appropriate use of local customs and languages for celebrating the rites of the liturgy. Finally, this document is rooted in the Paschal Mystery and theology expressed in the letters of the apostles, calling for restoration of Scripture in the Liturgy of the Word, in preaching and in scripture study. Sacred Scripture is the basis for the reforms initiated by *Sacrosanctum Concilium*. We remain one body in Christ called to a royal priesthood. I invite you to read this document with fresh eyes, minds, and hearts.

## Lenten Faith Formation ~ Begins February 19 ~ Register Now


### Are you looking for a way to journey through the Lenten season?



## Our Lady of Lourdes Feast Day February 11



On February 11, 1858, Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous – the first of 18 visits.

When she asked the Lady's identity, she replied, "I am the Immaculate Conception." The Blessed Virgin, through Bernadette, had come to call sinners to a change of heart.

Her message was a request for prayer and penance. She also said that a chapel was to be built on the site and processions held. On Feb. 25, the Lady told Bernadette to dig in the dirt and drink of the stream. She began to dig and found water to drink.

In 1865, after a thorough investigation, the apparitions were approved for devotion by the Catholic Church. A shrine was built there, which remains a popular place of pilgrimage. The latest (and 69th) approved miracle involving a healing in the water of Lourdes took place in May 1989. After extensive investigation the Church approved it in July 2013.

The water continues to flow from where she had dug with her hands until it was producing over 32,000 gallons of water a day – as it still does. Over 2 million people Lourdes visit each year.

Bernadette died in 1879 at the age of 35, and was later canonized. The body of the blessed Saint can still be seen in its glass coffin, intact and incorrupt, looking like a young woman asleep.
