


## Meditating Moments



At the risk of offending some readers, I would like to offer some of my thoughts on a Lenten tradition practiced by many Catholics: **Giving up something for Lent.** This graphic presents some suggestions, perhaps even one or two that fit your need. Although I

agree that most of these ideas are worth consideration, I wonder what is the value of such change only for the 40 days of Lent, which do not technically even include Sundays. For example, I have a friend who, every year, gives up chocolate for Lent. She explained to me that when she wants chocolate, yet refrains from eating any, she is reminded to pray. Seems logical, yet unsatisfying to me. My question: "What harm is there in eating chocolate?" Although I accept the idea of increasing prayer in her life, why stop when Lent is over? (Chocolate eggs and Easter bunnies await?) This understanding of giving something up only for Lent seems somewhat superficial to me.

Intellectually, if there is something in my life which seems to be harmful or for which there is a need for change such as eliminating a particular food, beverage, activity, habit, or way of being, I ask: "Why only during Lent?" Instead if I believe there is a need to change, (the idea behind Lent is through discernment and conversion, I am led to a richer life, of surrender and trust in Christ Jesus,) then why not pray for Him to give me the strength to make a permanent change. Back to chocolate as a simple example. I realize an addiction to chocolate, i.e. if it is around I eat it. As part of my discernment during Lent I recognize my addiction and ask Jesus to help me turn away from said addiction and turn to Him to fulfill my need. What appears to me as complete foolishness, would then be to indulge eating chocolate on Sundays and returning to my old habitual addition when Lent is over. Instead, what I begin during Lent, I beg God to help me continue for the rest of my life. Will I slip some time? Perhaps. Yet with God's help I can turn from my addiction, leave harmful thoughts, words, and deeds in the past, confess when I fail, offer contrition, and accept God's grace to a deeper, more loving, selfless relationship. I know this chocolate example may seem trivial and foolish to you, as I intended it to be, however, the point I am trying to make is that any change in my life which brings me closer to God should not be limited in time, a 40 day obligation. Any change which brings me closer to God must be life-long, else giving something up seems like nothing more than Lenten folly. For me conversion is on-going not time dependent. I pray for God's grace to change.



## The Chrism Mass Did You Know?

Every year there is a Chrism Mass at which the Bishop blesses the three oils that will be used in



the parishes for the next year. The oils from the previous Chrism Mass are used in the Easter Fire at the Easter Vigil.

The three oils are the Oil of Catechumens, Oil of the Sick and the Sacred Chrism.

- **Oil of Catechumens** is used to anoint those preparing for the Rite of Baptism. Children are anointed on the breast bone.

- **Oil of the Sick** is used in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, to anoint anyone that needs to be strengthened for an upcoming surgery, beginning of an illness or becoming more frail due to age.

- **Sacred Chrism** the only one that has an aroma, is used in Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders as an anointing with the Holy Spirit. At the Chrism Mass the Bishop breathes the Holy Spirit into the oil.

This year's the Chrism Mass was held at the Cathedral of Immaculate Conception last Thursday, February 26.



Good Shepherd is hosting the Eucharistic Miracles of the World panels sponsored by Catholic radio 1090AM.

What is a Eucharistic Miracle? These miracles consist of unexplainable phenomena occurring after transubstantiation, such as a host visibly transforming into human tissue, a host surviving fire, a host bleeding or the Eucharist alone providing sustenance to a human being for a prolonged period.

The panels which number around 157 panels captured the miracles of Eucharistic throughout the world and were the creation of Saint Carlo Acutis.

These panels will be displayed in our hall beginning on Friday, March 6th (in conjunction with our fish fry) from 5-9PM; Saturday, March 7th from 9AM-5PM; and Sunday, March 8th from 1-6PM. The exhibit is free and all are welcome to read and understand these miracles.
