

## From the Pastor's Pen

"Water" is a key image in the Scripture readings for this Third Weekend of Lent, both the first reading from the Book of Exodus as well as the Gospel reading. Water is a symbol of human needs and is also symbolic of God's provisions for our needs. We are called to trust in God's love for us.

So why, throughout history, are there sometimes drought and famine? Do these needs indicate a lack of trust in God's providence? Or do they teach us lessons about confidence in God's love for us? In the gospel story about the woman at the well, Jesus leads the Samaritan woman to faith using the image of water as a sign of God's love for His People. Listening to the gospel with attention and faith, we deepen our commitment and come to the well of God's love.

I want to suggest another meditation on water: the abuse of water. One such abuse is waste. Clean and potable water is not an inexhaustible resource. All of us need to use water in a responsible way. Why let water run from the faucet when we are not using it? Another abuse is pollution. Sadly, rivers, streams and oceans are harmed by careless habits. The seas suffer from chemical pollution, plastic pollution, noise pollution, acidification.

A good spiritual practice of Lent would be to look into our habits to judge of we are in any way the cause of waste or the cause of pollution to underground water, streams, rivers and seas. When you use water, think about what a gift it is and say of brief prayer of thanksgiving for this gift.

See water as a blessing of God, a sign of God's unending love for us.

Know that my prayers are with you each day.

Hopefully, I didn't lose readership with my thoughts in last week's bulletin. Today I also want to offer my personal thoughts about changes

which may begin as part of our Lenten journey, hopefully on a more positive note. I believe Lent is a yearly journey which I meant to bring me closer and more lovingly into relationship with others and in turn into greater love and devotion to Christ Jesus following His teachings.

I recently attended a gathering focused on prayer with three of our Muslim brothers. During our time together, they explained their practice of daily prayer as well as what fasting means in their tradition, especially during Ramadan. Each day of Ramadan they fast from food and drink from sunrise until sunset. The fast from food and drink, however, is not only what it means for a Muslim to fast. Every Muslim is also required to fast from anything which leads their life away from Allah; putting their wants, desires, time spent, and thoughts, ahead of loving, serving and giving praise to God. I realized, listening to these men speak, that this should be a part of my Lenten fast also. In the Act of Contrition, I pray that God will forgive me of my thoughts, words, and actions, in what I have done and what I fail to do. I seek the prayers of our blessed mother, Mary, all the saints, and my brothers and sisters, that I may receive God's grace to turn from temptation. I silently pray for a more God-centered life in Christ Jesus.

I found the above image helped focus my thoughts related to my Lenten fast, which as I indicated last week is only a prelude to my life-long change and conversion of heart. When I read the list of what I could give up, admittedly there was not one item that did not apply to me. On the opposite side I believe my gratitude, trust in God, and turning to forgiveness has improved. What remains is becoming more patient, positive, and optimistic. These three are works in progress, in which I often slip back into self-centered, egoistical habits. There is one in which I find myself stuck, seemingly unable to grow. "Give up hatred and return good for evil." Hatred is such a strong word, which I must unconsciously feel, because I know I hold grudges. I have difficulty letting go of past, hurtful experiences. For this, I pray, asking God to lead me in the direction of release, so that I may return good for what I judge to be evil done to me, to those I love, and to my fellow human beings. That said, I confess I am trying to give something up for Lent, but also asking God for the strength that any change becomes part of my life, permanently. Lord honor me with the grace to love and forgive as you do!

a season of spiritual preparation

## Did You Know?

The goal of Lent is to build new virtues or good habits in our lives through prayer, fasting and/or almsgiving. By doing this we are learning to live a life in which we honor, glorify and thank God for the sacrifice of His Son, Jesus. This week let's talk about prayer. Prayer is simply talking and listening to God. Your prayers don't have to be perfect. Just talk and express your concerns, your hopes and dreams, your needs. After all, prayer helps to build a personal relationship between you and God. Prayer can take many forms as you will see in the ideas below.

1. Take 15 or 30 minutes each day in quiet time by yourself to pray. Get a notebook and write a letter to God each day thanking Him for all His blessings and telling him your concerns and needs.
2. Read about the virtue of and pray for humility. Seek out opportunities to humble yourself in your relationship with others by giving someone else credit or recognition throughout each day.
3. Take some time to read the daily Mass Scripture readings each day. Read Bishop Robert Barron's thoughts each day for better understanding at [www.wordonfire.org](http://www.wordonfire.org). There's also a link on this website to the daily readings.
4. Go to Eucharistic Adoration each week on Tuesday and/or Thursday in the chapel. You can make a short visit or try to stay for an hour.
5. Forgive those who have offended you and pray for those who have hurt you.
6. Go to Mass every day. Invite someone who doesn't regularly attend Mass to come to church with you one day during the week.
7. Make a conscious decision before work, chores or study to offer up whatever you are doing in love to God. Do these with joy, not grumbling or griping.
8. Give thanks daily for the trials in your life with the confidence that God will turn them to good.
9. Continually look for the big and small blessings in your life. Keep a gratitude journal.

### Did You Know?



Being confirmed is a very important part of our spiritual growth. The Catholic Church believes that our souls need to grow in maturity in our life of grace. The Sacrament of Confirmation completes the process of our initiation into the Christian community con-

firming what was begun in Baptism and nourished in the Holy Eucharist. Our souls are given the grace, power and energy to go forth and become *soldiers of Christ*. We are given the spiritual duty to fight the war between good and evil, light and darkness, between the human race and the powers of Satan and hell.

In Confirmation we are given the same 7 gifts (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord) and 12 fruits (charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, forbearance, gentleness, faith, modesty, self-control and chastity) that were given to the apostles and Mary on Pentecost (See Acts 2:1-4.) The 7 gifts are supernatural graces given to the soul, while the 12 fruits are human qualities activated by the Holy Spirit that give us the courage to practice and live our faith as disciples of Christ. It is in and through Confirmation that we accept responsibility for our faith and our spiritual destiny and we acknowledge that we want Christ to be the center of our lives.
