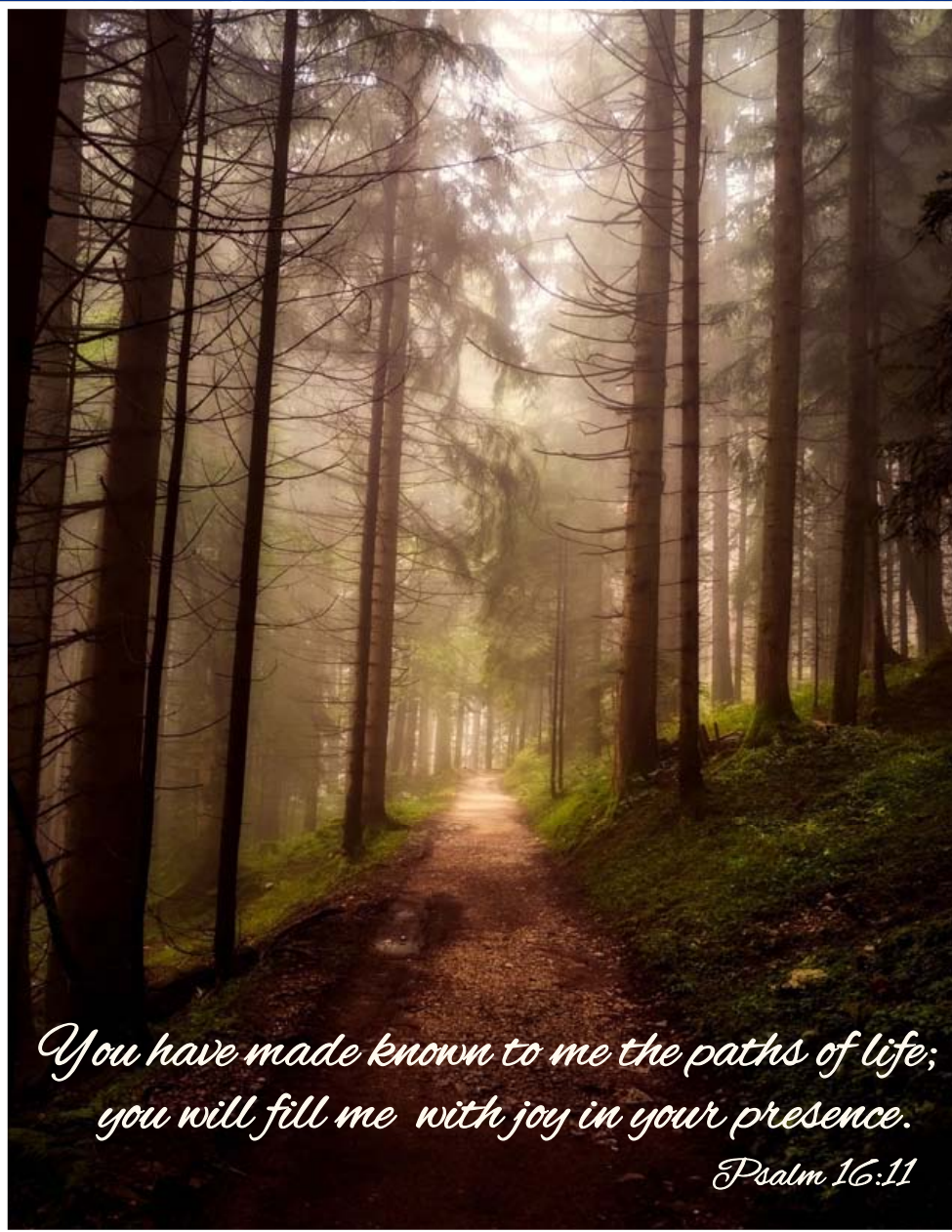

### Roses for Mother's Day



This year we will again be doing the Roses for Mother's Day event honoring all Mothers, Grandmothers, and/or Mom figures, living or deceased.

This event is the main fundraiser to support the church landscaping needs. For over 20 years we have kept the rose donation at \$3 per stem. Although the donation envelope says \$3, due to the rising prices, we kindly ask you now to increase the rose donation to \$5 per stem.

Envelopes for your donations and to list the names of those you wish to honor can be found in your packets and on a table in the Gathering Space. They can be placed in the collection basket or in the designated box in the Gathering Space or at the Parish Office now thru May 4.

After Mother's Day, the roses will be taken to parish individuals who are home bound.

Proceeds from this event are used to maintain the Prayer Garden and other campus landscaping.

## From the Pastor's Pen

One of the claims to fame of my hometown of Nebraska City, Nebraska, is the founding of "Arbor Day," which happened on April 10, 1872. When homesteaders came to settle in Nebraska, there weren't many trees. It was the vision of J. Sterling Morton that a tree-planting campaign begin. It is estimated that over a million trees have been planted in Nebraska since that first Arbor Day. In 1883 a campaign was begun to establish Arbor Day nationwide. The day of observance may change, but the usual celebration is in April. The year 1970 saw the birth of "Earth Day," which widened to scope of Arbor Day, fostering all activities which protect the earth, air, water, and environment.

In May of 2015, Pope Francis issued an encyclical called by its Latin title, "Laudato Si," a landmark statement on protecting the environment. He calls the earth "our common home" and pleads for responsible stewardship of the earth by all people of all nations and religions. Yes, it is true that the creation story in the Book of Genesis states that humans are given dominion over all creation (Gn. 1,26). But that does not mean human beings have the authority to use creation in whatever benefits or pleases. A better understanding is that we are stewards of all created things. We are given the responsibility to protect creation, the earth, the air, the water. Abuse of creation for our own desires or selfish and monetary gain is a great violation of stewardship.

In 1225, Saint Francis composed his well-known and beloved Song of Praise. Francis begins by his praise of God, words that inspired the title of the encyclical "Laudato Si." All the earth belongs to God. He praises "Brother Sun" and "Sister Moon," "Brother Wind," and "Sister Water." We all share the beauty that comes from the creative hand of God. My plea for all of us is that we hear the message of this beautiful encyclical of Pope Francis, that we embrace responsible stewardship. May we all treat the earth as "our common home."

My prayers are with you each day.

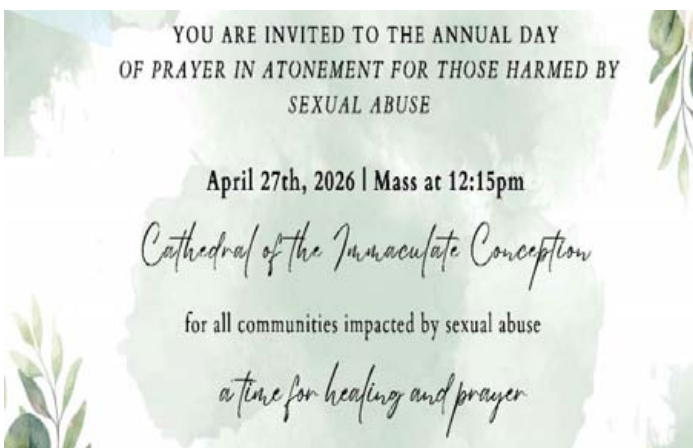

### Meditating Moments



Anyone driving by my house or stopping for a visit will most likely be aware of the fact that I like plants. Point of fact, I continue to enlarge my outside gardens, because plants, especially flowering plants, make me feel joyful, peaceful, and surrounded by the presence of God. (I also prefer less grass to mow.) Although I select plants for my gardens which bloom at different times during the year, Spring is a special time for me. After the barrenness of Missouri winters, Springtime is full of vivid colors and new growth. How fortunate we who live in the Northern Hemisphere also celebrate Easter during these months of new growth and natural beauty. (The Southern Hemisphere is entering fall; a time many people view as a season of dying rather than the beginnings of new life.) Many spring flowers in my gardens, including the beautiful Easter Lilies, grow from bulbs which are dormant (not lifeless) during Missouri's fall and winter. When I see the first shoots, sometimes breaking through snow, I am reminded of Christ's resurrection. What a wonderful and beautiful reminder of God's gifts; new life rising from barren earth, emerging in fragrant and vivid colors.

I recently read a meditation by Fr. Richard Rohr where he wrote: "We don't need to wait for death to experience resurrection. We can begin resurrection today by living connected to God." He continues that "resurrection happens every time we love someone even though they were not very loving to us." Sharing Christ's love I experience new life. When I decide to trust even though the other person betrayed my trust, I rise to new life. When I encounter failure but begin again, when I refuse to be negative, pessimistic, hopeless, or feel the need to retaliate, I experience the Risen Christ. Like the resurrection of nature's beauty, I experience resurrection every time I open my heart to God and seek forgiveness and guidance. The resurrection of Jesus is not His private miracle. Richard Rohr concludes that resurrection is "the new shape of reality. It's the new shape of the world. It's filled with grace. . . possibility. . . newness [of life]." Resurrection is not intended to prove the divinity of Jesus; resurrection is offered to me each and every day; calling me to become closer to its infinite Source, Christ Jesus. The world in which I live is filled with an abundance of life. I desire to embrace this infinite abundance rather than immerse myself in a perceived world of scarcity. I desire to share resurrection and life. God's gifts, God's grace, Jesus's message of love, mercy, and service are not something for me to hoard. Jesus taught I must lose, give myself in love, in order to receive. Even through my barrenness, resurrection is now; It is for everyone.

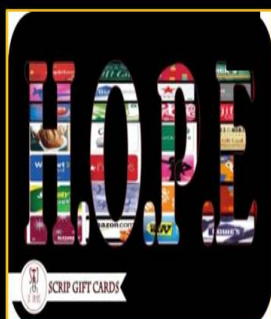

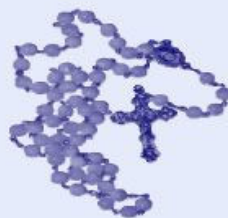
