MISSION APPEAL SUNDAY
CONTINUING THE MISSION OF CHRIST
Caring For Those in Need

On this annual Mission Appeal Sunday, our St. James parish community is scheduled to welcome a missionary from the Congregation of the Passion of Jesus Christ, abbreviated as CP. He would come to share with us some of the current missionary activities of his religious order responding to the command of Jesus to serve those in need. Unfortunately, he will not be able to come.

Nevertheless, we still celebrate this Mission Appeal weekend as a rare opportunity for each and everyone of us to remind ourselves and one another that ALL members of the Church, by virtue of one's baptism, are to participate in the Mission of the Church, that is, to continue the Mission of Christ caring for those in need.

The Prophet Isaiah in the 1st reading shouted out God's invitation to the exiled in Babylon who in despair perhaps, had almost given up: *"All you who are thirsty, come to the water! ..."*

(Isaiah 55: 1ff) I would like to call out one of my 'broken records': *"He [The Lord Jesus Christ] now anoints you with the Chrism of salvation, so that you may remain members of Christ, Priest, Prophet, and King, unto eternal life."* As priest/priestess we offering sacrifices of praise and thanksgiving to God in behalf of humanity. As prophet/prophetess we are prodding conscience in response to the injustices ravaging our humanity (wars, famines, genocides, ignored victims of crimes and natural disasters...) As king/queen we lead one another into action doing *"the work of God."* (cf. John 6:28; Matthew 19:16; Mark 10:17; Luke 10:25; 18:18)

May we bring to date what Saint Paul said to the Romans: *"We know that all things work for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose."* (Romans 8: 28) How can we continue to celebrate the Lord's Supper and not remember His mandate: *"... give them some food yourselves."*

Meditating Moments



There are many times when I wonder what it would be like to live, eat, and walk with Jesus; to be His student disciple. Although I read and study His words, how

wonderful it would be to stand in His presence and share time with Him. I think it would be amazing to ask questions and listen to His voice providing answers, perhaps even new challenges.

Reading my Bible today, I feel overwhelmingly challenged by His teachings - the Beatitudes. In Matthew, Chapter 5 Jesus says: "Blessed are those who are persecuted in the cause of justice, the kingdom of heaven is theirs. Blessed are **YOU** when people revile you and persecute you. . . Rejoice and be glad, for **YOUR** reward is great in heaven." This passage presents so many questions. First I never thought of myself as persecuted in the cause of justice. Second I have felt reviled (criticized in an abusive or angrily insulting manner) for my words spoken or actions taken that are, centered in my understanding of justice for all, but I did not feel gladness or rejoicing. I could not, nor can I now understand the necessity of disagreements/challenges by other people descending into abusive criticism, which leads to anger and division. I believe such discourse accomplishes nothing. Disagreement which engages people through constructive dialogue, new understanding, and perhaps consensus or compromise, however, is certainly beneficial and may evolve into new social/cultural ideas.

Reading Jesus' words I often feel frustrated. At this point in my life, however, I continue to believe that Jesus is admonishing me to work toward becoming a person who advocates for and works toward peace and justice (in whatever small way I can) even when it means facing what seems like unjustified revilement. I think Jesus was addressing social issues, concerns, and rejection of individuals in His time to any who heard His voice. I also believe Jesus is speaking to me in the same manner. Jesus did not ignore injustice. He spoke boldly against anyone who might harm "the little ones," which I interpret as anyone without a voice or means to defend themselves; not only children, but the poor, those suffering illness or disabilities, those treated as objects for the benefit of the powerful, those cast aside by society as somehow unworthy, disgraceful, or simply different.

I think Jesus is calling me to an awareness and actions which cherish and protect today's outcasts.

Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord Thursday, August 6



The feast of the Transfiguration of Christ celebrates the revelation of Christ's divine glory on Mount Tabor. After revealing to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem, Christ, along with Sts. Peter, James, and John, went up the mountain. There, Saint Matthew writes, "he was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow."

For Peter, James, and John, it was also a glimpse of the glories of heaven and of the resurrected body promised to all Christians. As Christ was transfigured, two others appeared with Him: Moses, representing the Old Testament Law, and Elijah, representing the prophets. Thus Christ, Who stood between the two and spoke with them, appeared to the disciples as the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets.

At Christ's baptism in the Jordan, the voice of God the Father was heard to proclaim that "This is my beloved Son". During the Transfiguration, God the Father pronounced the same words.

NOTE: Each time we enter our Sanctuary, we are reminded of the glory of the Transfiguration as we see the large mural (33 feet 2 inches in height and 14 feet 7 inches in width).

Looking closely, we see Christ at the upper center with Moses and Elijah at His right and left. The three disciples are on the mountain: Peter at the lower left in a kneeling posture, John at the upper or summit of the mountain, and St. James, further down the mountain.

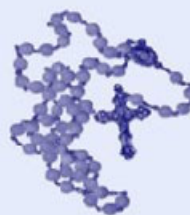
