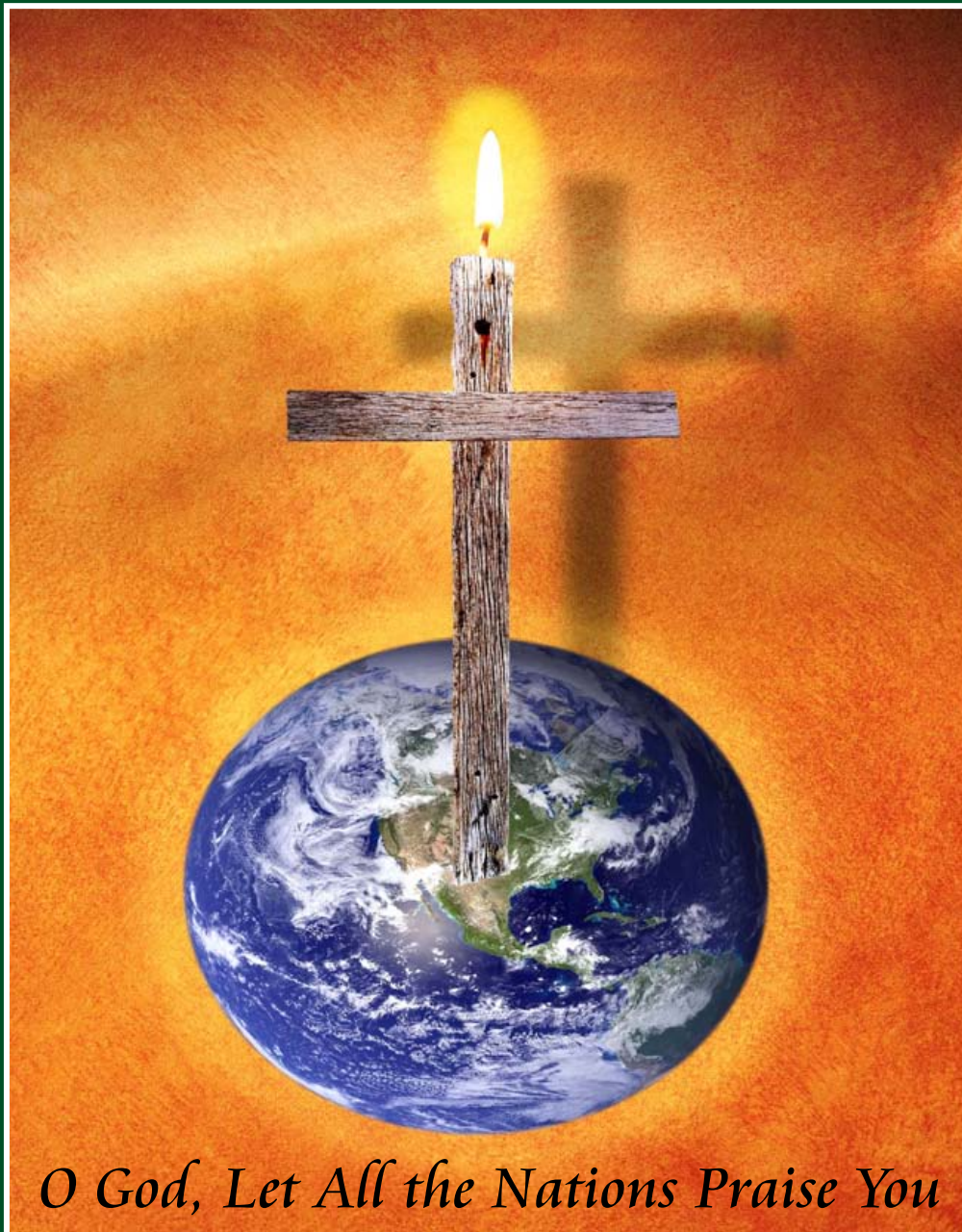

Blue Line / Red Curbs

A vital way to protect your fellow parishioners with a low time commitment.

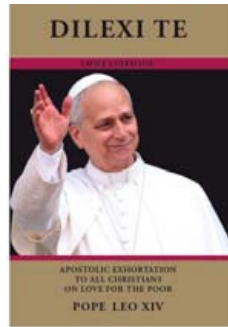

Meditating Moments



Although I previously wrote about Pope Leo XIV's words found in *Dilexi Te*, I would like to revisit what seems to me to be the basic concept of this Apostolic Exhortation: "I Love You." Perhaps my words last week seemed to come from a dark place in my life. I must assure you, quite the opposite.

While there is much in our culture and society which seem to be dark and discouraging, I do not find myself with feelings of despair or hopelessness. For me there is always light, brightness, and hope found in the teachings of Jesus as well as insights from Pope Leo XIV. In a July 29 interview, Pope Leo said: "I think of myself first as Pope who happens to be an American." He continued by restating that his mandate is to always be true to the revelation of Jesus Christ, embrace God's people, and work toward peace; God's gift to all humankind is grace, forgiveness, peace, and love. God's love for all humankind challenges me as I read Pope Leo's words in *Dilexi te*. Re-reading and meditate on the Gospel message, I more fully realize that yes I am blessed and **CHOSEN** by God. I am beloved by God but this doesn't mean that I am better or above others in God's heart. What being chosen means to me is more a summons of what God is calling me to be. I believe I am chosen to bring the good news to others, perhaps in words, but mostly through my actions. I realize that not everyone has been fortunate enough to receive the truth revealed through scripture, tradition, faith formation, and communal praise, prayer, and song. I do not believe, however, that I am more exalted or holy because of my experiences. Through them I feel an awareness of God's presence in my heart and mind which strengthens and empowers me to humbly and unselfishly carry out kingdom work. Such tasks are not for any personal award but solely for giving praise, glory and thanks to God. I do not believe there is any stratification of God's abundant love, which as humans we attempt to create and maintain through an **US** and **THEM** mentality. Any person to which I offer love, acceptance, and aid is not **the other**, but rather **my neighbor, my brother, my sister, and God's beloved child**. There are many times when I feel ignorant, not understanding where or how God calls, but I know I am **chosen** for mission to love, reconciliation, and service to God and one another. **I/WE ARE LOVED! There is no division in God's love; it is freely given to God's creation.**

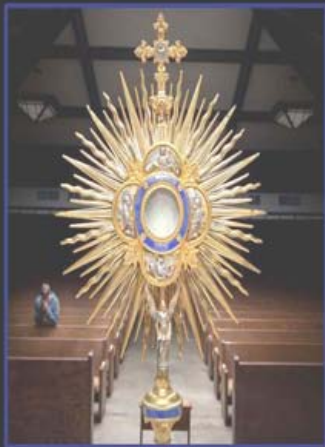

The custom of requesting a priest to offer the Mass for a specific intention, is a longstanding tradition in the Church.

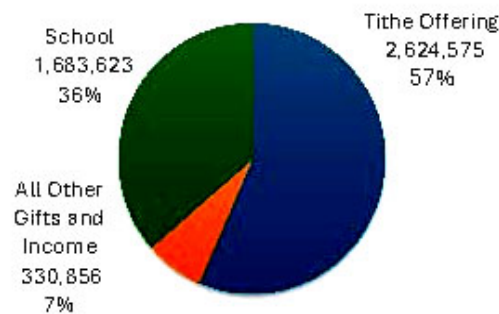
When we celebrate the Eucharist, in addition to prayers for the deceased, a particular intention may be included.

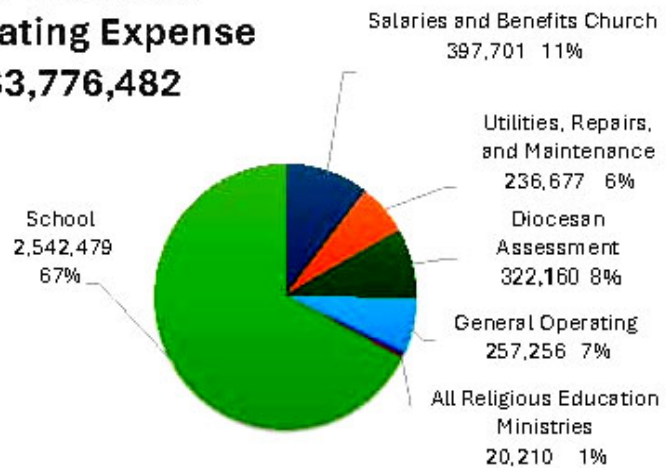

\$4,639,054**

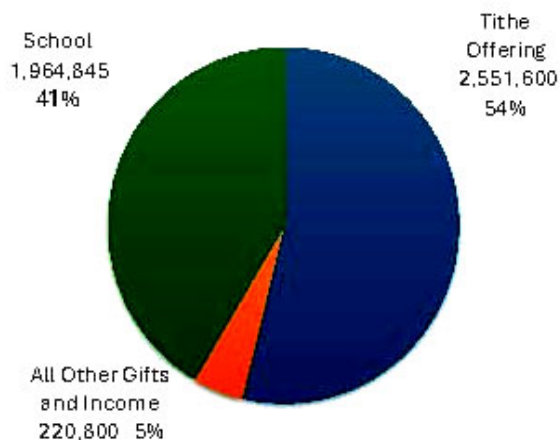


**25-26 Actual

\$3,776,482**

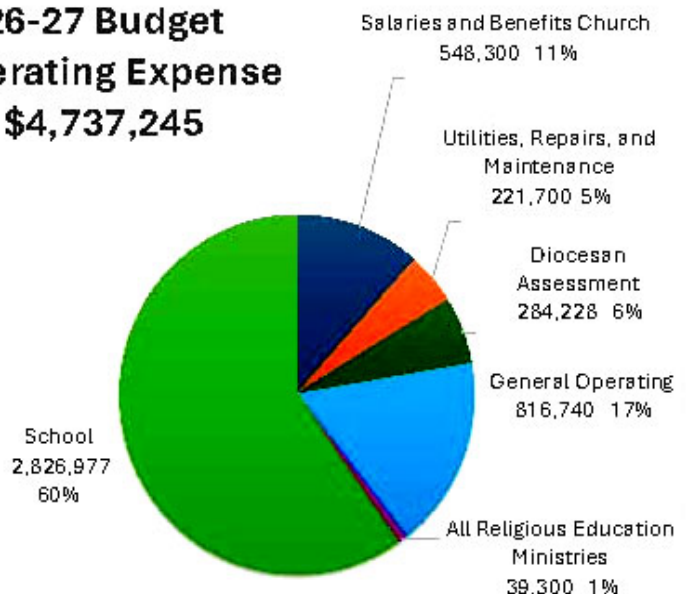


Budget of Operating Income and Expense

THANK YOU! Thank you for supporting our parish family! On behalf of Fr. Lac, the parish staff, and the Finance Council, again - thank you. We support many organizations and people local, nationally and internationally. You have big hearts St. James. Your commitment to providing for our parish now and in the future is a beacon on the horizon.

A few things about the numbers: 25-26 are actual with the additional monies going into the savings account for future repairs, needs, plans. The budget – we are a zero based, balanced budget accounting system.

We are moving forward with the remodel plans for the Social Hall, St. Gerard Space and School entry. More on this will be shared as information becomes available. We will need 50% in the bank and 75% pledged of total cost estimate before we will begin. This is a rule from the diocese, and it has served us well, holding us to fiscal responsibility with loan amounts and interest expenses.

If you have a student who will begin 6th grade or higher this fall, and they have completed their First Sacraments, they may be registered for Confirmation. The registration link can be found on the parish website.

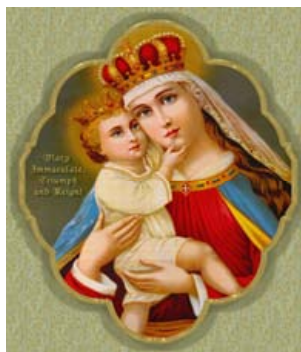

The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 22



August 22 is the Feast of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a day when we celebrate Mary as the Queen of Heaven and Earth.

The Catholic teaching on this subject is expressed in the papal encyclical *Ad Caeli Reginam*, issued by

Pope Pius XII in 1954.

It states that Mary is called Queen of Heaven because her son, Jesus Christ, is the king of Israel and heavenly king of the universe.

Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

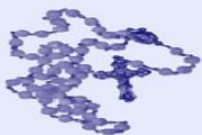

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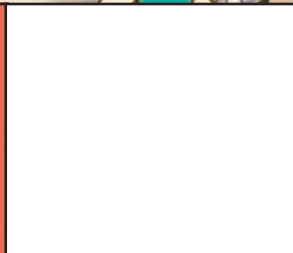
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
