From the Pastor's Pen

"For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if we die, we die for the Lord; so then whether we live or die, we are the Lord's." (Romans 14: 8)

Dear Members of Saint James Parish,
At the beginning of the celebration of baptism of a child, the Cross of Christ is signed on the forehead of the child to be baptized. Though this simple ritual action is often overlooked or ignored by witnesses at the event, it signifies a very important happening in the relationship between Christ and the person being signed: Christ claims this child as His Own. This child now belongs to Christ. Any deities, any spirits, or any persons who mess with this "possession" of Christ will have to deal with Christ himself.

N., the Christian community welcomes you with great joy. In its name I claim you for Christ our Savior by the sign of his cross. I now trace the cross on your forehead, and invite your parents (and godparents) to do the same. (Rite of Baptism of a Child)

It is from his faith conviction that Saint Paul declared to the Romans at the end of his letter to them. Anthropological evidence points out that the human race from the very beginning was aware of the presence of some invisible beings whose power was manifested in its visible world. They were commonly known as gods and spirits, perceivable in the sky – thunders, lightnings; in the storms – powerful winds, washing away torrents; on land - high mountains, dense forests, vast and deep-water bodies; ... Wise as the human ancestors were, they sought out and pledge their loyalty to the most powerful gods/spirits known to them. They believed that once the god/spirit accepted their pledge of loyalty, the god/spirit claimed them as their own and thereby protect and defend them. We may want to look deeper into the Covenant that God made with Abraham, the Christians' "father in faith".

Christ has claimed each of us, the baptized, as his own, indelibly marked on our foreheads. May we in turn deeply convict ourselves as persons truly belonging to Christ.

Meditating Moments



Last week, I wrote about my three youngest grandchildren and their ever-changing lives. I also attempted to explain why I see myself as a seeker. During our time together, my grandson and I also had a discussion about our Christian beliefs which

included a discussion of “salvation through faith or through works.” We both agreed that salvation is not a matter of either/or; rather salvation through Christ Jesus depends on both faith and works. He said, “Because I have faith (specifically in the life, teachings, death, and resurrection of Jesus). I feel my actions must reflect my faith. I cannot do what ever I want, whenever I want, without regards to others. My actions/works are grounded in the love of Jesus.” I was amazed at his insight, while also realizing that many adults continue to argue and disagree, quoting select scripture to justify their positions. He realizes the necessity of both. Our discussion lead me once again to the Book of Job. During both undergraduate and graduate studies, I was assigned to read Job and write papers relating to my understanding of the text. I found this difficult and must admit, completing these assignments, focused on why good things happen to bad people, was not my best work. Now, however, re-reading and reflecting on Job I believe it is a story of love and conversion. Job, while acknowledged as a just man who followed the law, was urged by his closest friends to atone. Job was blinded by self-righteousness and lack of intimacy with God. When confronted by the true nature of God, as creator, lover, and giver of divine mercy, Job’s conversion of love and intimacy with God flourished. Job told God, “I know that you can do all things, and that no purpose of yours can be hindered. I have dealt with great things that I do not understand; things too wonderful for me, which I cannot know. I had heard of you by word of mouth, but now my eye has seen you. Therefore, I disown what I have said and repent in dust and ashes” (Job 42:1-6 NAB). In my mind, Job’s intimate relationship with God begins with this confession. In essence he said, “I recognize that you are God; I am not and that is good. I do not understand your ways but I know your love and mercy. I trust and believe that all things are possible through you. Every good work of my hands is a result of my faith that you are ever present, lovingly guiding me.” As a seeker, is my relationship with God intimate, trusting, and loving?

IS this for KIDS too?

While traditional sacramental preparation through Religious Education is the ordinary way for children to experience our Catholic sacraments, this might not be the right path for all children. OCIC (Order of Christian Initiation of Children) is for children:

- **over the age of 7**
- **who have not been baptized or have been baptized in another Christian denomination**
- **who wish to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church.**

The program educates children on key Catholic teachings and prepares them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, Communion and Confirmation - often during the Easter Vigil. The program includes:

Sacrament Preparation: It prepares children to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion.

Faith Formation: It provides a comprehensive religious education, focusing on the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church.

Church Membership: It allows children to enter into Full Communion with the Catholic Church.

Seeking Hope Ball Honoree Nominations

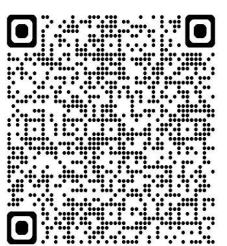
Do you know a **Catholic teen** who makes a difference through their faith?
