From the Pastor's Pen

Each year on September 11, we celebrate "Patriot's Day," a day set aside in our country to remember the tragic event of the terrorist acts which destroyed the Twin Towers in New York City and took nearly 3000 lives. We honor the victims, the survivors, and the heroism of the brave first responders. It is a day of infamy that we will never forget.

The word "Patriot" also reminds us of the men and women of the American colonies who risked their lives and fought so courageously for freedom. As we continue to remember the 250th anniversary of our American independence, we reflect on what a difference the Declaration of Independence made for Catholics. Some have called the celebration "Catholic Freedom Day." We may forget that it was illegal to practice the Catholic faith in the original 13 colonies. Catholic churches, monasteries, and school were practically non-existent. Priests were few and far between, mostly hidden in their ministries. Masses were celebrated in private homes. Only about 1% of the colonial population was Catholic. A 1647 Massachusetts law forbid Catholic priests in that area. Catholics were barred from holding public office.

One shining light was the Catholic voice of Charles Carroll of Maryland, a signer of the Declaration of Independence. He helped draft the First Amendment to the Constitution guaranteeing freedom of religion. Yes, what a great document, the Constitution and its Amendments. We have much to celebrate on this 250th Anniversary of that Declaration of Independence. As equal citizens we join in praising God for our country and its Constitution.

St. Teresa of Calcutta

Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu was born of Albanian parents in Skopje on August 26, 1910. She embraced a missionary vocation, and entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Loreto in 1928.

After joining the congregation, she was sent to India. On September 10, 1946, she received a "call within a call" to serve the Lord in the poorest of the poor.

Accordingly, after two years she began an apostolate to the multitude of the poor and destitute, founding the Congregations of the Missionaries of Charity, for both women and men.

Accepting with serenity the pain of interior darkness, she demonstrated in a remarkable way the victory of the light of Christ, until she faithfully entrusted herself to eternal rest in Calcutta on September 5, 1997

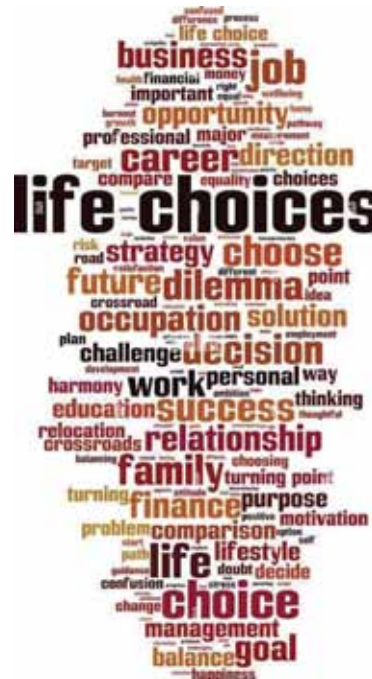

Meditating Moments



My two youngest granddaughters left home last month for college. One is transferring from the community college near her family home to begin her junior year at Colorado State University. The other starts as a freshman at Colorado School of Mines. While excited to begin this new chapter of their lives, both have expressed feelings of apprehension about their futures to me.

Their revelations should not be surprising to me. Even at this point in life, I feel some anxiety and

definite uncertainty about my future from time to time, particularly when new opportunities and choices await. Where should I choose to put my energy and abilities? What is around the next corner awaiting discovery and my attention? So many choices, but at this time not one seems the path I wish to choose. While I enjoy my freedom resulting from total retirement and job responsibilities, I also feel at loose ends. I want to be of service, in some capacity, yet not bound by a fixed, rigid time schedule.

When my youngest grandson, asked me to describe myself, I said I see myself as a **seeker**. As a seeker, I use my experiences, knowledge, and trust in God to find truth. The question is, "What am I seeking?" Is it knowledge, wisdom, inner peace, joy? Or pleasure, fame, economic stability, and wealth?

IS this for KIDS too?

While traditional sacramental preparation through Religious Education is the ordinary way for children to experience our Catholic sacraments, this might not be the right path for all children. OCIC (Order of Christian Initiation of Children) is for children:

- **over the age of 7**
- **who have not been baptized or have been baptized in another Christian denomination**
- **who wish to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church.**

The program educates children on key Catholic teachings and prepares them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, Communion and Confirmation - often during the Easter Vigil. The program includes:

Sacrament Preparation: It prepares children to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion.

Faith Formation: It provides a comprehensive religious education, focusing on the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church.

Church Membership: It allows children to enter into Full Communion with the Catholic Church.

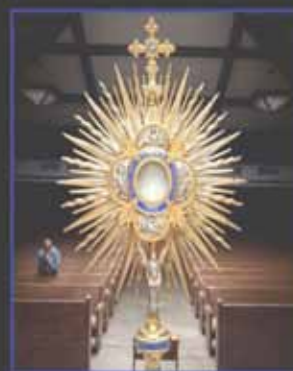

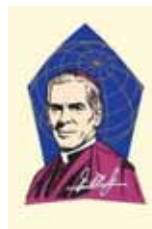

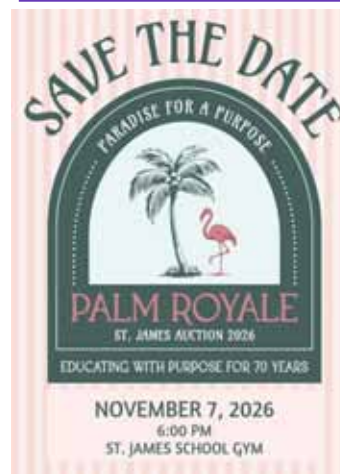
